

Simple Explanation for Zakat Calculation:

Assets:

- ❖ Cash and Bank Balances (1)
- ❖ Placements with Financial Institutions (2)
- ❖ Investment Securities (3)
- ❖ Property and Equipment (4)
- ❖ Total Assets (5)

Liabilities:

- ❖ Investors Fund (6)
- ❖ Islamic Financing Liability (7)
- ❖ Other Liabilities (8)
- ❖ Total Liabilities (9)

Equity:

- ❖ Share Capital (10)
- ❖ Statuary Reserves (11)
- ❖ Retained Earning (12)
- ❖ Total Equity (13)

$$\text{Zakat Pool} = X - Y = W$$

$$\text{Where } X = (1) + (2)$$

$$Y = (7) + (8)$$

$$\text{Zakat} = W \times 2.5\% = i$$

$$\text{Zakat per Share} = i \div \text{total Number of Shares}$$
